Upon approval of the budget by Oconee County Council, the Commission is authorized to expend funds in accordance with the approved budget and in compliance with all applicable laws, county policies, and procurement requirements.

6. **Amendments**

The Commission reserves the right to recommend amendments to the budget during the fiscal year, subject to approval by Oconee County Council where required.

7. **Effective Date**

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption, and the budget herein shall become effective upon approval by Oconee County Council.

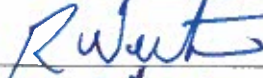

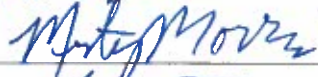

RESOLUTION OF THE CORINTH SPECIAL PURPOSE TAX DISTRICT FOR FIRE PROTECTION:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CORINTH SHILOH SPECIAL PURPOSE TAX DISTRICT COMMISSION ADOPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2026–2027 BUDGET FOR FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES AND REQUESTING APPROVAL BY OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL, SOUTH CAROLINA

WHEREAS, the Corinth Shiloh Special Purpose Tax District (the “District”) was established pursuant to the laws of the State of South Carolina and by action of the Oconee County Legislative Delegation for the purpose of providing fire protection services within the District; and

WHEREAS, the Corinth Shiloh Special Purpose Tax District Commission (the “Commission”) serves as the governing body of the District and is charged with the responsibility of preparing an annual budget and recommending the same for approval by Oconee County Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to applicable provisions of the South Carolina Code of Laws, including Title 4 and Title 6, and the established practices and requirements of Oconee County, the Commission is required to submit a proposed annual budget for review and approval by Oconee County Council; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has prepared a proposed budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2027, setting forth anticipated revenues and expenditures necessary for the continued operation and provision of fire protection services within the District; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has reviewed the proposed budget in a duly called public meeting held in compliance with the South Carolina Freedom of Information Act, Chapter 4, Title 30 of the South Carolina Code of Laws, and has determined that the budget is balanced and necessary for the provision of services; and

WHEREAS, the Commission finds that the proposed budget is reasonable, fiscally responsible, and in the best interest of the residents and taxpayers of the District.

WHEREAS, The Districts general expenditures for the fiscal year 2026-2027 are approved in the amount of **1,335,850.00**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CORINTH SHILOH SPECIAL PURPOSE TAX DISTRICT COMMISSION, IN MEETING DULY ASSEMBLED:

1. Adoption of Proposed Budget
